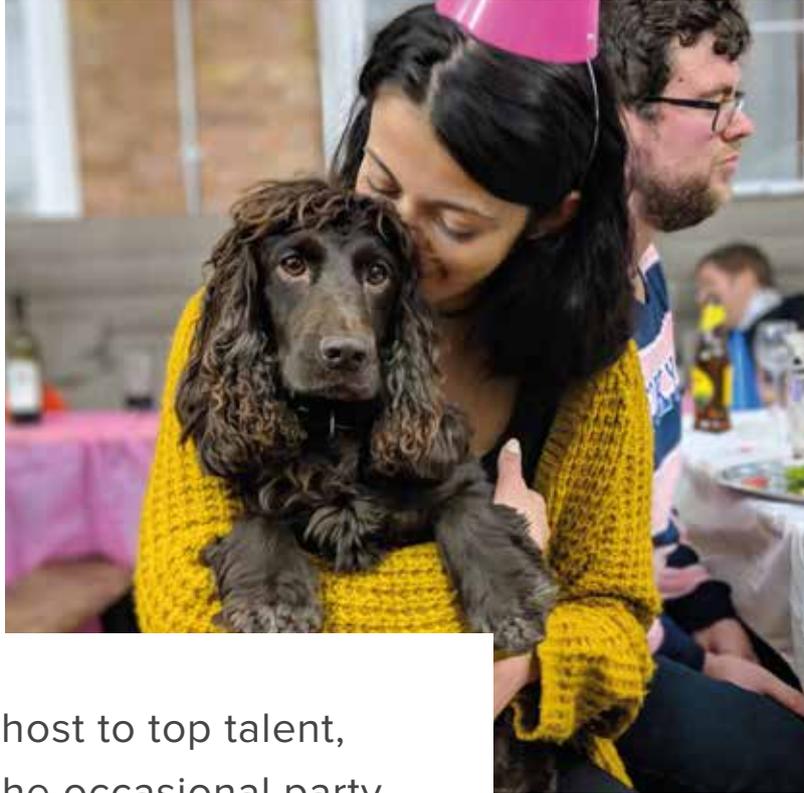

- 06** Other ad-hoc duties as required

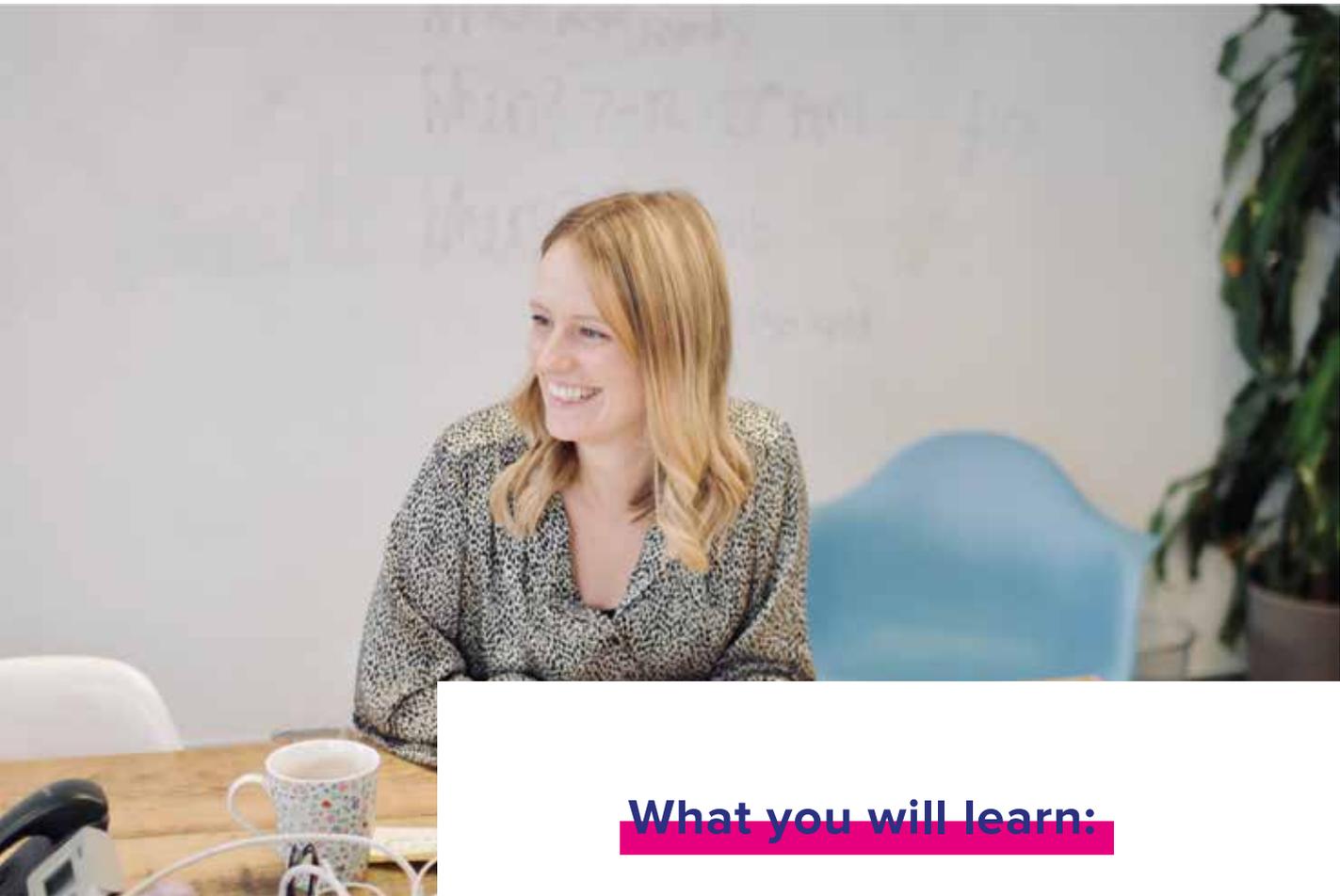
Experience:

- You possess the ability to prioritise to tight deadlines with a strong sense of initiative and discretion.



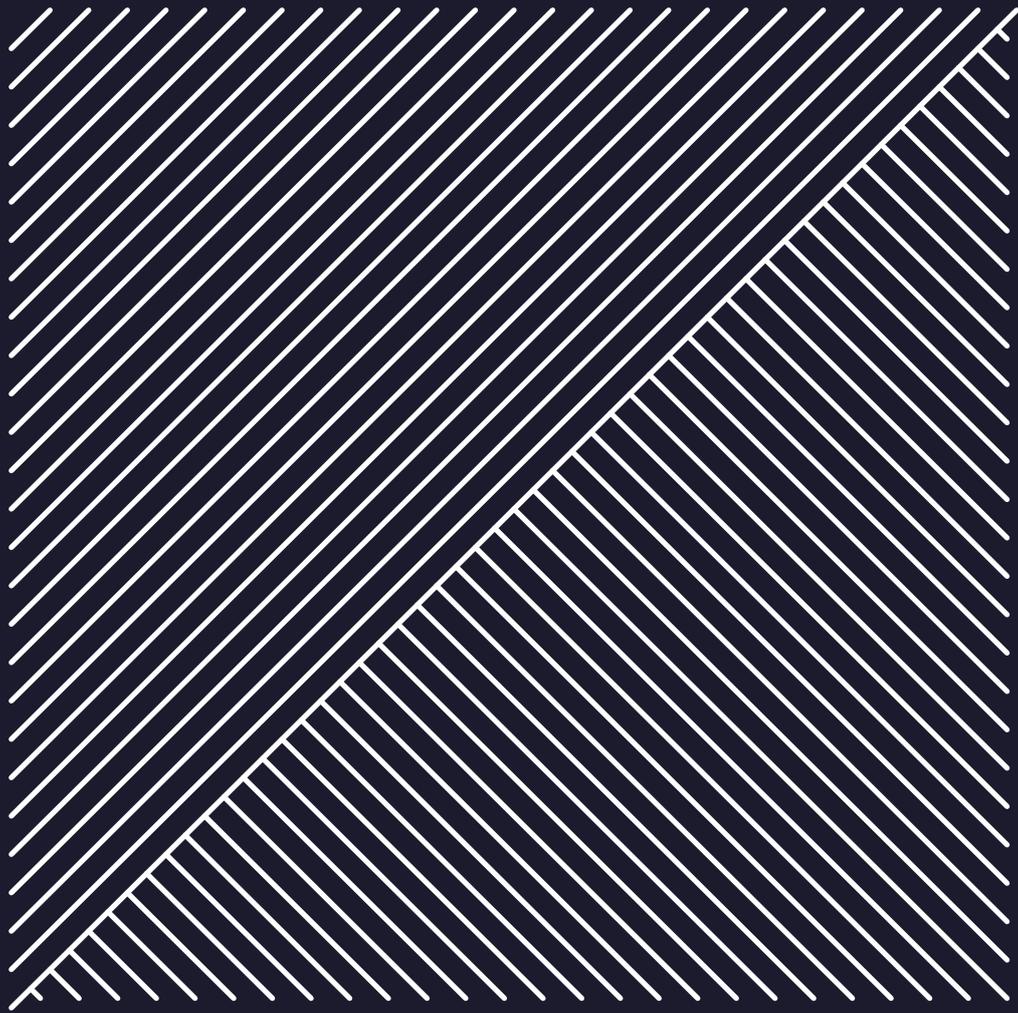
